This certificate must contain contact hours completed, dates of training, and the course identification number per 18 VAC15-40-260 of the Board's regulations. You will also be required to establish and maintain records for each student per 18 VAC 15-40-270. Those records shall be available for inspection during normal business hours by authorized representatives of the Board. Records are to be maintained for a minimum of five years.

Per 18 VAC 15-40-280, any change in the information provided in your original application for course approval must be reported to the Board within 30 days of the change. Any change in information submitted will be reviewed to ensure compliance with all provisions in the Boards' regulations.
